

Shoppers help Hart Lions spread Festive Cheer

The Hart Lions were also busy when they held a food collection at their local superstore, Morrisons. Non-perishable food was donated by weekend shoppers, with the aim of making up Christmas hampers to be distributed to those less fortunate in the Fleet area.

Everyone who took part was amazed at the generosity of the local people. Over the weekend more than eight full shopping trolleys of food were collected, enabling the Hart Lions to make up and distribute 30 parcels to individuals, 20 to local families through the Lions Community Store, a very large parcel of groceries, toiletries and cleaning materials to Step by Step, a local homeless project, and further deliveries to local care homes and projects.

Community Services Chairman Marilyn Robson, said: "We were able to make up many more hampers than we have previously, allowing us to give a little extra to a lot of people in the area. For many people this is likely to be the only gift they receive this Christmas"
