

# Dedicated Tree Lights

*help raise vital funds for hospices*

**H**art Lions Light up a Life campaign raised over £1400 for two local hospices this Christmas. The campaign, which has now been running for eight years, invites local people to remember their loved ones by dedicating a light on the Christmas Tree at Fleet's Hart Shopping Centre.

The two hospices, Naomi House Children's Hospice and the Phyllis Tuckwell Hospice, serve those living in the Surrey/Hampshire area. Naomi House costs £6000 a day to run, whilst the Phyllis Tuckwell running costs are £10,000 a day.
